From the Pastors......

Jesus, keep me near the cross, there's a precious fountain; free to all, a healing stream flows from Calv'ry's mountain. In the cross, in the cross be my glory ever; till my ransomed soul shall find rest beyond the river. ELW 335

With Easter quickly approaching, there is much to be excited about! We love how packed the church can be on Easter morning. We love how we sing all the beautiful Alleluia-filled hymns with much gusto (you know, assuming the Alleluias are sent back in the mail). We love the festively dressed children who have a little extra pep in their steps thanks to their sugary Easter baskets. We love being able to proclaim, "Alleluia, Christ is Risen," and then hearing you confidently respond back, "Christ is Risen indeed! Alleluia!"

We suspect many of you cherish these same elements of Easter—the congregational involvement, the music, the energy, the emphasis on the hope and new life we have in Christ(!). And after years of celebrating in the midst of the pandemic, perhaps we appreciate these elements all the more! But, in order to get to all of the festive elements of the season, we have to do something else first: we have to go through the season of Lent. And to go through Lent, we encounter many of the more unpleasant sides of Jesus' story, of our story—the temptations, the betrayals, the abandonment, the sin and, eventually, the crucifixion.

Lent is a season that we've never heard people speak as "glowingly" about as we just did for Easter. Lent isn't something that we should probably like. Similar to intense two-a-days in football or the last weeks of a semester that build up to final exams, the intent of Lent is not enjoyment per se. The point is more about preparation, reflection, study, growth—it gets us ready for something else, something bigger.

In Lent, we often sing Jesus, Keep Me Near the Cross. We make this fitting request for Jesus to keep us close to the cross because, internally, we really don't want to be anywhere close to it. We don't want to be near the cross, because, at that location, we are reminded too vividly of our own sin, of our own brokenness, and of our own mortality. Instead, and reasonably so, we want to be close to the empty tomb and we want to sing all of those beautiful "Alleluias!"

But here's the thing—if we haven't dwelled in the sin, brokenness, and death of our own lives, what's there to celebrate with the resurrection of Jesus? Where's the need for forgiveness. Where's the need for healing? Where's the need for new life?

Holy Week provides an opportunity for us to dwell and to spend time at that precious fountain. And when we do, God's love can flow over us in all sorts of transformative ways.

If, for various reasons, you've wanted to plug more into worship during the Lenten season and haven't had an opportunity to do so yet, well, you're in luck because there's still time! Check out the front page for service times. Whatever extra worship opportunities you're able to be involved in will not only help enhance your Easter experience, but your faith can also be enriched, too.



Finance Team

February financial gifts brought in \$44k, YTD we are at \$373.9k. Preschool registration and summer camp enrollments are going very well. They are looking for eligible (potty trained) 2-year-olds to enroll for next year. Spread the word, if anybody is looking. On the Expense side, we've experienced some problems with the church van that required repairs (\$1.1k). Our AC system and fire security system had their semi-annual inspections (\$1.6k and \$860 respectively). Electricity bill \$2.5k, starting to go down with better weather, \$1.3k guest musician fees. We are still at an overall surplus of \$31.5k. We have invested \$80k of capital campaign seed money in two certificates of deposit. They will mature in 9/23 (5% interest) and 3/24 (5.25%) and bring about \$3k of interest income. ~Madalyn Wilkinson, Director of Finance.


