From the Pastors.....


Do not be afraid, for I have redeemed you. I have called you by name, you are mine. Isaiah 43:1

"Hey...you!" We've all been there before. We see someone in our neighborhood, or at the grocery store, or at church, and we know we should know their name, but our mental rolodexes just cannot completely locate them in the moment or we never were able to learn their name to begin with. It can be an awkward and embarrassing feeling, which can make us hesitate to engage with them in further conversation. So, general pleasantries are exchanged, and we then continue to move along.

Names can be tricky to learn. Here at CIC, learning names can be extra challenging given our location in the Lake Norman Area and the regular movement of people in and out of the region. The faces we see on Sunday are routinely changing. Who is a visitor? Who is a member? Who is here every couple of weeks visiting family? And yet, challenges aside, we all know just how important it is for us to learn and know each other's names. When someone knows our names and we know theirs, our connectivity is strengthened. A relationship with depth becomes possible. But, without names, at best we are cordial acquaintances to each other, and we desire a more welcoming and inclusive community than that.

As we shared at the Annual Meeting on May 21st, the Church Council has been working on ideas to help us, as a family of faith, learn each other's names which will, hopefully, help people feel more welcome and included. These are the two big initiatives that have come from our conversations:

Finance Team

April financial gifts brought in \$48k, our year to date contributions are \$473.3k. Our spending of note this month included: preregistration for the Synod Assembly (\$900), computer software costs (\$700), fire/security repairs and routine inspections (\$1.3k), utilities (\$1.8k), guest artist fees (\$1.9k). We show a year to date surplus of \$50.9k. This will begin to taper off a bit as we go into May and June without regular preschool tuition revenue, but with normal payroll and year-end maintenance spending. We have invested an additional \$50k in an interest bearing Fidelity Money Market account (total there \$100k) to take advantage of attractive interest rates. As a reminder, we also have \$80k invested in high yield Certificates of Deposit. ~Madalyn Wilkinson, Director of Finance.
