Open up the book of Acts and you can see that Paul was always on the move. Open up the following books of Romans, 1 & 2 Corinthians, Galatians, Ephesians, Philippians, and 1 & 2 Thessalonians, and you can see that Paul had a clear message to convey wherever he went.

While the faith has been passed on to us from generations of disciples before us, some disciples, like Paul, have extensively documented paths. A faith enriching opportunity can be traveling in those paths and seeing the stories written on pages come to life through the sight and sound and touch of the region, while guided by knowledgeable and experienced people.

CIC will be co-hosting a trip following some of Paul's footsteps, Journeys of Paul in Greece, through "Educational Opportunities Tours" (EO Tours) in partnership with Huntersville United Methodist Church (HUMC). We will have our own registration process through CIC, but our partnership with HUMC will allow us to benefit from the knowledge HUMC has gleaned from past EO Tours and enable us to travel as a larger group of neighbors both through the air and on the busses.

The trip departs on April 26, 2025, for 8 days, traveling through Neapolis, Amphipolis, Philippi, Veria, Thessaloniki, Meteora, Delphi, Corinth, Acropolis, and Athens. An optional Greek Isle Cruise Extension making the trip a total of 11 days also travels to Ephesus, Patmos Crete, and Santorini.

Priority registration is open for currently enrolled students, siblings, and church members.

- **\*\*Non-refundable registration fee of \$85.00 per child is due at time of enrollment. \*\***
- Tuition for 2024/2025: \$295.00 for 2-year-old and 3-year-old students and \$340.00 for 4-year-old, PK and TK students. Tuition is due on the 1st of the month, with September's tuition due on May 1st, 2024. We currently have openings in the 2 yr. old class, the 4 yr. old class and the TK class.

## Finance Team

April gifts brought in \$49.3k, a strong month, we thank our Members for their increased giving following the two Council appeals. Preschool has one more regular school month left, then we move on to summer camps. We continue to enroll students for next year. We have spots open in ALL age groups. Please share with friends and neighbors. Other Revenues brought in \$1.5k this month, \$600 from Thrivent Choice dollars, \$\$825 from facility use, remainder from credit card rewards, MM account interest. Total Revenues for the month were \$66k, YTD: \$586.9. On the expense side, Computer/Software: \$1k, in addition to normal fees, we had a renewal of WIX website hosting service and annual Zoom subscription; Insurance: Paid the next quarterly installment of \$3.9k offset by \$1.3k refund from PY Workers' Comp policy premiums; Building Maintenance: \$455, repair of leaky pipe under bathroom sink; Utilities/Electric: \$1.6k continues to go down with the weather. Total Expenses for the month were \$59.9, YTD: \$526.1k. We ended March with a Surplus of \$5.8k, which finally puts us in a Combined YTD Surplus position of \$620. We are making progress! In addition to Operating Expenses, we used \$3.3k from the Capital/Emergency account to pay for electrical repairs and work on another broken AC unit (which will need to be replaced soon). ~ Madalyn Wilkinson, Director of Finance.
