#### From the Pastors.....

In the morning, while it was still very dark, Jesus got up and went out to a deserted place, and there he prayed. ~Mark 1:35

It took 3 winters in North Carolina, but the Beerys finally got to experience a long-awaited snowfall. Two of the Beerys were far more excited about this than the others. Regardless, we all thoroughly enjoyed the time spent sledding, building snowmen, creating forts, drinking hot chocolate, and watching movies under comfy blankets. That recent experience reminded us of an old Scandinavian saying that we came to know quite well while in northern Minnesota:

If you choose not to find joy in the snow, you will have less joy in your life but still the same amount of snow.

A few quick takeaways from that proverb...

- \* It is easier to find joy in the snow when little kids are around to play with.
- \* It is easier to find joy in the snow when you know it will melt in a few days versus last for months, and months, and ...
- \* The proverb, while accurate, is not really about snow, though. It is more about our perspective and attitude—we can control those far more easily than whatever circumstance in which we may find ourselves.

The circumstances we have been immersed in over the last 2 years have been far from desirable. The realities of pain and loss weigh heavy on us from the pandemic, and as we all find ourselves trying to tread water during yet another COVID wave, feelings of joy can seem illusive.

In times like these, we are reminded of how Jesus, when placed in extremely difficult circumstances, would take opportunities to be by himself to pray. Those moments provided Jesus with occasions to recenter, refocus, and ground his perspective in God's promises before continuing on in his ministry.

To be sure, 20 minutes of prayer, or study, or worship, or acts of service will not necessarily transform feelings of malaise into joy instantaneously. That time focused on God can, however, *strengthen* our faith in God's presence and love which can then *help* us to more clearly see and experience joy in whatever circumstances we encounter.

This endless snowfall we find ourselves in doesn't seem to be concluding any time soon. Feelings of resentment, anger, sadness, fear, indifference...they are unquestionably a part of the piles we keep accumulating. Such feelings do not have to be the defining elements of the season though, because God is here, God is with us, and that means so, too, is life, and love, and joy.

We should always strive to carve out opportunities to be with God, to recenter, refocus, and ground our perspective in God's promises. In moments when we are feeling overwhelmed, this discipline becomes even more important. As our metaphorical snowfall continues, may you be blessed to find moments of joy no matter how deep piles become.

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#### From the Finance Team

December was a strong month for CIC. Our Member Contributions for the month were \$60k, which puts us at \$257.8k at the halfway point of the Fiscal Year (48% of budgeted amount). The only expense of note to report was the payment of \$10k of ERC processing fees. All required forms have now been filed with the IRS and we await resolution (expected timing 6-9 months). We have ended the year with an operating surplus of \$19,820. Looking to the month ahead, work has started on the flooding remediation project. As a reminder, this project is fully covered by the Emergency Restricted Fund and will not impact our operating results.
