# Sunday, February 4<sup>th</sup> & 11<sup>th</sup> – Souper Bowl of Caring

For over 30 years, the Souper Bowl of Caring movement has been inspiring people across the nation to tackle hunger in their local communities. Since 1990, over \$170 million has been reported donated to local food charities across all fifty states with over 300,000 unique groups participating.

On Sundays, February 4<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup>, a special offering will be collected as we'll be participating in Souper Bowl of Caring for Angels & Sparrows in Huntersville.

How does it work? 4 "soup bowls" will be in the narthex on February 4<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup>. Place your donation in the bowl of the team you would like to win or are predicting will win this year's Super Bowl. An update on which team is in the lead will be given between Sundays.




#### During the season of Lent, you will notice some variation in our Sunday morning worship together:

- $\Rightarrow$  The paraments are the color purple, a color representing repentance and solemnity.
- ⇒ The Canticle of Praise is omitted from our liturgy. We will move directly from the Kyrie to the Prayer of the Day omitting the song of joyous glory as a way of practicing quiet contemplation.
- $\Rightarrow$  The Gospel Acclamation is the setting for Lent.
- ⇒ During Holy Communion, the Great Thanksgiving and Preface will always be spoken as a sign of solemnity.
- ⇒ We refrain from saying the word Alleluia as we "fast" from this word which means, "Praise the Lord."

On Wednesday, February 21st, a Taizé worship service will be introduced that we will use as our liturgy for the 5 Midweek Lenten services that follow Ash Wednesday. Taizé (pronounced "teh-ZAY") worship is a meditative form of worship centering us on Christ's presence with us which originates from a religious community in southern France founded by Brother Roger in 1940. Each week during the midweek services, we will hear from different members of the church council and congregation about how stewardship is impactful in the life of the church.



Lenten Devotionals will be available for pick up beginning Sunday, February, 4th.



# From the Pastors......



I praise you, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made. Wonderful are your works; that I know very well. Psalm 139:14

For over 100 years, Lutheran youth have been gathering in regional and national assemblies across the country. These gatherings have proven to be one of the most impactful faith-enriching experiences that young adults have. In addition to deepening and broadening their faith in Christ, the gatherings have been a powerful means of building relationships amongst the participants and further connecting participants to the work of the greater church.

Community in Christ has a history of attending National Youth Gatherings and we are excited to send another group this summer as we gather in New Orleans with tens of thousands of youth from across the country July  $15^{th}$  – July  $20^{th}$ . The theme for this gathering is *Created to Be* and is based off of Psalm 139. The theme is expanded to focus on how God has created us to be: Brave, Authentic, Free, Disruptive, and Disciples.

To prepare for this experience, our 8 youth and 3 adult leaders have begun a series of getting ready materials that will expose us to elements of the theme. In addition, the series will help prepare us for what life in New Orleans is like for the many residents who make up one of the most culturally and ethnically diverse cities in the country.

In the coming weeks and months, you'll also learn of ways you can help support the group who will be attending the NYG.

- Currently, the participants have teamed up with the card ministry to create many of the cards in the card's turnstile in the narthex. Proceeds from the sale of cards in January and February will be given to the group.
- In addition, on February 11<sup>th</sup>, the group will be leading the Shrove Sunday Pancake Breakfast between worship services. All are welcome to attend the breakfast and the free-will donation will go towards the group's travel expenses.
- The 5 Midweek Lenten Meals that begin on February 21<sup>st</sup> at 6 p.m. will be set up, served, and cleaned up by gathering participants. The free-will offering at each of those meals will help
- off-set the group's costs.
  Other fundraising opportunities will likely be in the future. In addition to these financial gifts, your prayers are always coveted.

May the Spirit move amongst this group and the whole Church so that we more fully embody the beautiful (and often messy) life and call that God has created us for.

#### <u>Finance Team</u>

December gifts brought in \$56.9k. YTD, we are now 3% behind the Budget, at \$247.4k. Preschool enrollment stands at 50 total, their December Revenue was \$14.6. Other Revenues were \$1.15k, between interest income, Thrivent Choice dollars, facility use, and credit card rewards. Our Total YTD Revenues are \$329.8k. On the expenses side, items of interest were: Postage: \$110 (Christmas mailings). Office Supplies: \$300 (copy paper, stationery, misc. supplies). Auto Insurance: \$693 (paid the balance of our annual premium to avoid installment fees). Mileage Reimbursement: \$300. Pastor Substitute: \$200 (Pastr Marcus). Music – Special Programs: \$155 (Christmas Pageant). Music – Guest Artists: \$175. (cello player). Youth – Milestone Ministry: \$130 (baptism supplies). Preschool Substitutes: \$480. Total Expenses for the month were \$57.9k, YTD: \$338.6k. Our YTD Deficit is \$8.8k. The recent Handbells fundraising towards their retreat brought in one large lump sum gift of \$5k, plus \$670 in small amount donations. Additionally, the Preschool's fundraiser, Jingle Jog, brought in \$2,670 that will be used towards classroom expenses and equipment replacement. ~Madalyn Wilkinson, Director of Finance.
